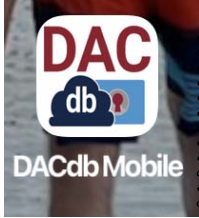

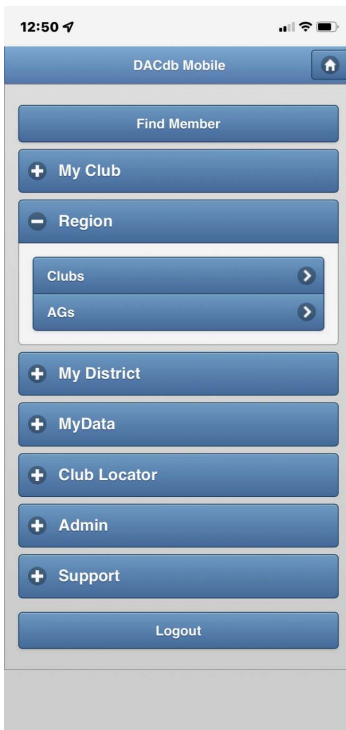

Recent Speakers

On January 4th, Rick Eastman, Assistant Director of the Lake of the Ozarks Shootout, addressed our club. The Shootout started in 1988 as a charity event for the Osage Beach, Lake of the Ozarks and Lake Ozark fire

departments. Each of these departments, through volunteers, helped to staff the event. The tradition of local fire departments and other groups benefiting from this charity event continues today. Currently, 8 fire departments and 32 charity groups are beneficiaries of the funds raised through the Shootout. In 2022, the Shootout reached a milestone event of raising \$625,000.00. Rick is projecting that the events in 2023 could set another high donation mark for the Shootout. Lake of the Ozarks Shootout raises funds through race sponsorships, a silent auction and a poker run. The monies raised from the events that make up the Lake of the Ozarks Shootout continue to be donated to local fire departments and charities. This continued support and focus on local groups allows these groups to continue needed services and support to individuals and families in our area.
