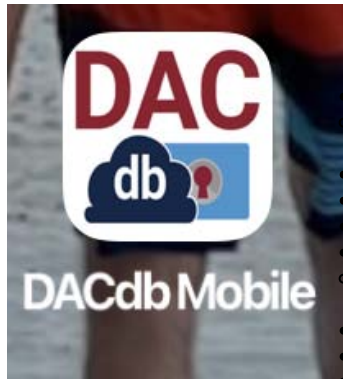

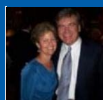

Recent Speakers

On January 11th, Krista Carter, Executive Director of Medical Missions for Christ Community, addressed our club.

In 2000, a group of Lake of the Ozarks residents began volunteering for annual overseas medical mission trips. On one trip, volunteers expressed concern about people back here, in our home community, who were unable to get the healthcare they needed due to low incomes and lack of health insurance.

At the same time, another local group was exploring the idea of starting a free clinic where volunteers would provide care for those who couldn't afford to pay. God brought these two groups together and in 2006, Medical Missions for Christ Clinic opened its doors. Since 2006 the group has helped thousands of people who needed medical care but could not afford care. The group offers primary care, dental care and eye care. The group also provides prescription assistance, mammograms and chiropractic care.

Our patients are residents of the greater Lake of the Ozarks area. They are low income (under 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, based on size of household) and uninsured, underinsured, or are otherwise unable to access the care they need.
