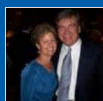

#### Recent Speaker

On March 8th, Camden County Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton addressed our club. Commissioner Skelton expressed his dedication to the business of running our county. While previous commissioners have treated the job of serving as our county's chief executive as part-time, he has realized that the job is a full-time commitment, helping the 294 employees and the county's constituents adequately. The county is currently looking at partnering with the video company CGI. CGI has been approved as a vendor by the National Association of Counties. CGI produces videos highlighting the attractions, history, and highlights of living in and visiting Camden County. Local businesses could be sponsors of this promotional video. Sponsoring businesses will be highlighted in the video. As the new executive for the county, Mr. Skelton is responsible for all county vendor agreements. He reviews all contracts to ensure the county's needs are adequately represented and met. He is also looking at the cost of the deals to ensure that the county's funds are being appropriately utilized. There has been a needed increase to the Road and Bridge budget implemented recently. Much work is being put into updating the State Cart Map to reflect the accurate county road responsibilities. The county commission will also be updating the county's master plan. The current goal is over 15 years old and no longer represents the zoning and needs of the county.
