**Recent Speakers:** On March 15th, Natalie Couch, Executive Director of Lake Area Industries Inc., addressed our club. Natalie told the club members that LAI is one of 92 sheltered workshops in Missouri. Over 7500 Missourians with disabilities are employed through this network of private workshops. LAI assures its employees are in a safe environment, allowing them every opportunity to enhance their knowledge and improve and gain professional skills. Natalie stated that LAI, in particular, emphasizes vocational skills and cooperation, and its motto is One Team, One Dream. In addition, Lake Area Industries, Inc. provides contract packaging and assembly, secure document destruction, dock foam recycling, and a seasonal garden center. Recently, LAI has started providing housekeeping and laundry services for the Laurie Care Center. This service began in September of 2022 and is a first of its kind within the sheltered workshop program. This new service has already shown significant benefits for LAI's workers and the patients and staff of the Laurie Care Center. LAI is a not-for-profit corporation overseen by a volunteer board of directors. LAI accepts through its website at [www.LakeAreaIndustries.org](http://www.LakeAreaIndustries.org) or by check. By supporting Lake Area Industries as a business, they can lower the impact on your bottom line. You will be giving back to an organization that cares about this community and provides excellent opportunities for individuals within our community with disabilities.
