Recent Speakers: On March 22nd, Teresa Millsap, Administrator for Aging Best, and Barbara Reed, Board President for the Camden County Senior Citizens Association, Inc., addressed our assembled members. The Camden County Senior Center, now called the Camdenton Senior Center Activity and Nutrition Program, is run by Aging Best, an area Agencies on Aging affiliate and a local volunteer board. Teresa and her staff of two employees ensure that our area seniors have at least one healthy meal a day and arrange for the activities held at the center. In addition, the board of directors cares for the building and the overall operation of the property. Meals are offered Monday-Friday from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm. Currently, 72 area residents receive meals through the meals on wheels program. The Department of Health and Senior Services approves all meals served at the center and to home-bound people. While meals are free for seniors, there is a suggested contribution of \$5.00. If you are under 60, you are welcome to come in for meals; there is a charge of \$7.00 per meal for anyone under 60; if you are looking for an opportunity to volunteer, the center would be grateful to have your help. There is a need for additional support in the following areas: hostess desk staffing; working in the dining room; delivering meals on wheels; re-packaging homebound meals; serving on the association board; conducting exercise classes; helping with fundraisers; helping with BINGO; teaching computer, smartphone and tablet classes and help with minor building maintenance. A weekly menu is printed in Lake Sun Leaders and on the group's Facebook page. Please check out this wonderful caring group providing much-needed, caring, and stabilizing services and opportunities for our area seniors.
