Guest Speaker: On November 1st, Carol Hoorman, Health Educator for First Impact addressed the assembled club members. Think First Missouri offers no-cost participation programs. Carol specializes in the First Impact program, a traffic safety program that educates parents about Missouri Graduated Driver License (GDL) law as well as provides the attendees with the tools they need to monitor, coach and support their new teen driver. The 90 - minute evidence-based traffic safety program's goal is to reduce the number of minor vehicle fatalities, injures and crashes among teen drivers by increasing parental awareness and enforcement of Missouri's GDL law. Additional programs offered by ThinkFirst Missouri! are: ThinkFirst for Teens: A high school/middle school presentation with a health educator explaining the basic anatomy of the central nervous system and permanent physiological changes caused by brain and/or spinal cord injury. ThinkFirst for Kids and Youth: Designed for grades K-5 this provides young people with lessons on decision-making skills. Smart Riders: A Missouri Department of Transportation program that can be done in the classroom. The four modules go over booster/seat belt safety, cycling, pedestrian walking safety and distracted driving with elementary school-age children.
