The time and care of the set up, decorations and delivery of the meal was extraordinary. The club voted to donate \$7,500.00 to Young Life. The remainder of the funds will be held for use with the sponsorships of Rotary Exchange students, grant requests received by the club and scholarships. Motion made by Ron and seconded by Adrian.

This year the planning of the event did not have a set point person who coordinated the event and allowed for a clear reporting structure for members to communicate with. Adrian stepped forward to Chair the 2024 Committee. Adrian will reach out to Lake Valley for dates in 2024 so the group can decide next year's event. Sudsey Supper Committee meetings should start in February.

The group needs to choose our charity for the 2024 and 2025 programs. LINA is currently the front runner. The group would like an application process for groups. Layla will search for application templates. The club would also like for the charity chosen to help with ticket sales and marketing of the event. We need for there to be a greater awareness within the community of this event.

The Power of Four- this was a success and the club believes it should continue. This donor designation gives us a terrific platform to grow. Ideas: Have the Power of Four locked in as early as possible. Allow the Power of Four sponsors to hang banners at the event. Allow push cards from the Power of Four sponsors to be at the table. Consider swag bags of give away items from the Power of Four for dinner participants.

The segment on Grant was very well received. The group is considering adding an award for community service in Grant's name. We could also use the Paul Harris Fellowship program as a delivery method for a community service-based award. The group agreed these are great ideas. Club members interested in helping develop this, please reach out to Jeff, Adrian, Layla or Ron.

The silent auction was wonderful. Thank you Adrian for all of his work. For 2024 outreach to donors for our event should start prior to the season being in full swing. Our area businesses are approached by numerous individuals and groups for donations. As the summer progresses, they lose the ability to fully participate. We should consider an earlier outreach with a save the date mentality for basket items.
