The Club enjoyed an informative presentation by Dr. Linthicum, who has been our Superintendent for the past four years. Dr. Linthicum explained that the vision of the District is to be the premier district in the state, building on the pillars of learning, partnership, and stewardship. Our mission is to give every student hope for a better tomorrow. Dr. Linthicum reviewed several statistics regarding the health of our school district as well as the excellent progress we have made over the past four years in improving literacy (50% to 58% at grade level from 2015 to 2018) and increasing our score on the Annual Performance Report (70.7% in 2015 to 87.9% in 2018). Finally, Dr. Linthicum reviewed a long list of priorities for the District, with the overall message of setting high standards, taking ownership of problems, and stressing collaboration in solving them. The Club went away feeling very well-informed and thankful that we have a superintendent who is eager to communicate within our schools and community
