### Kyle Kittrel

And finally, the Breakfast Club thoroughly enjoyed a presentation made by Kyle Kittrel on his trip to Nepal in November 2018. Kyle spent three weeks working both with the Aashish Presbyterian Church, where he helps oversee a child sponsorship for up to 30 children, and with Habitat/Thrivant. Kyle explained that although the earthquake was nearly four years ago, a vast amount of rebuilding is still in progress or needed. He showed the group how foundations are built in the new homes that make them much more earthquake-resistant, and he explained that he had the great pleasure of working with members of the lowest caste in Nepal to rebuild their homes in one of the many small villages that Habitat is supporting. He also explained that Thrivent Financial has committed millions of dollars each year to Habitat and is a key partner in building and rebuilding projects around the world.
