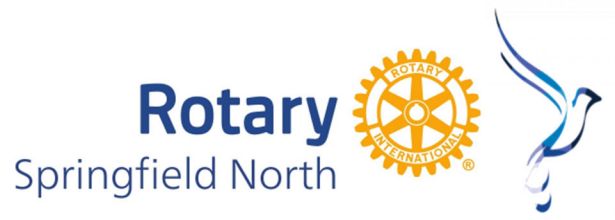

Program: **Veronica Bell**, Community Engagement Director with the Greene County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) addressed preparing for disasters: Preparedness, Response, and Recovery. Preparation (for self, community, and global community) includes where to go and where not to go, etc. Response is what to do and who is going to do it, and "plan B" if planned responses are foiled. Recovery entails adjusting to a new normal. Communities need to be educated about emergency plans and ideally, practice implementation. Churches, schools, businesses, as well as families need Emergency Operations Plans including what to do / where to go before emergency responders can arrive. A 90-minute class on-line addresses the five steps: Call 911, Stay safe, Stop the bleed, Position the injured without moving the casualties, and Provide comfort. Every airport must annually do an emergency response exercise. The OEM has a Watch Officer monitoring hazards, weather, etc. 24/7/365. More prepared...less fear.
