His career has taken him all around the Midwest with varied job duties including deer culling, being an airport biologist, a feral hog trapper, a disease biologist and removing pigeons in industrial areas.

Josh's career has always revolved around helping the public with negative human/wildlife interactions. Josh specializes in resolving conflicts with wildlife including, but not limited to, human health and safety, property damage, disease monitoring and agricultural protection.

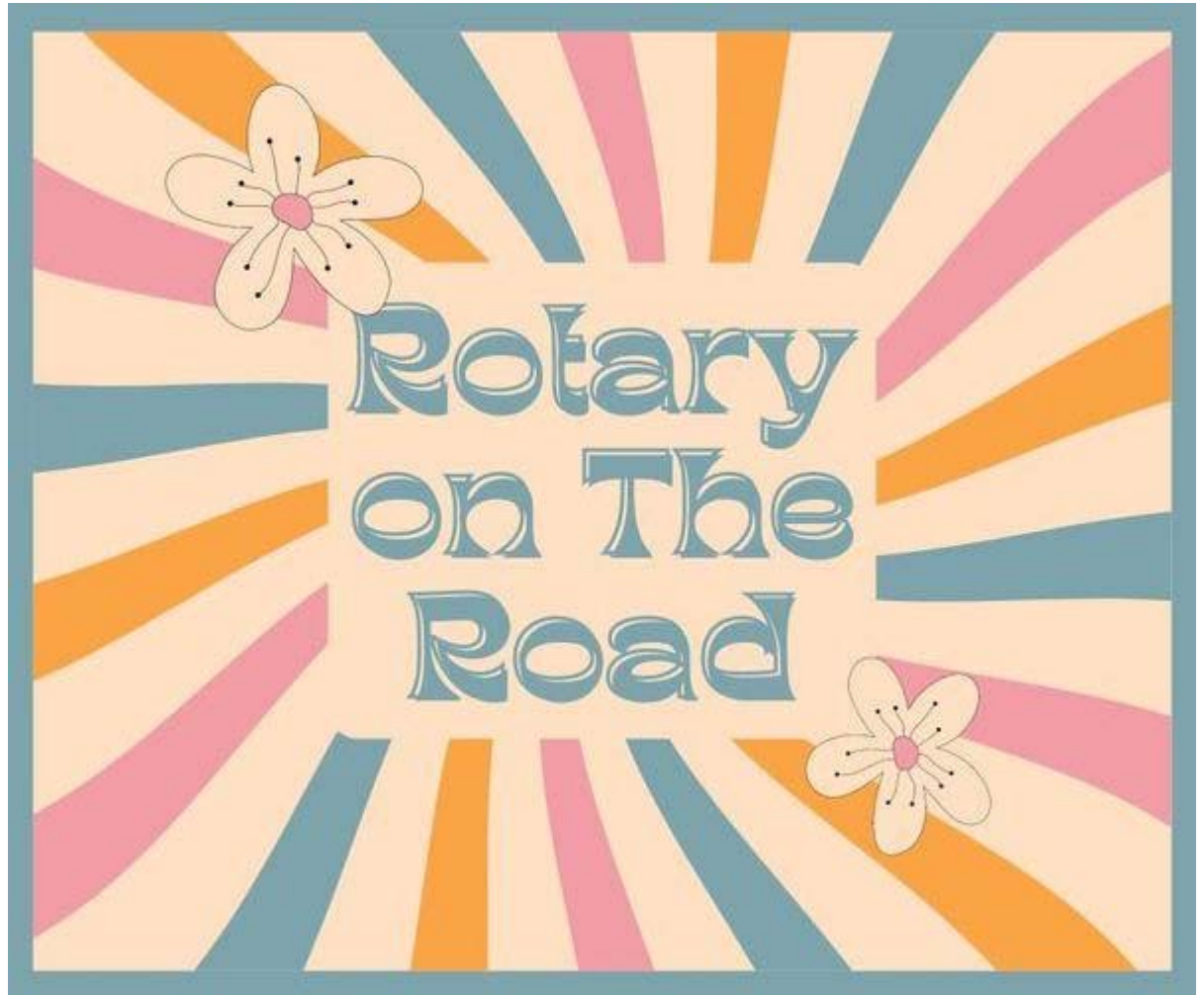
