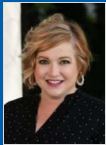

Josh specializes in resolving conflicts with wildlife including, but not limited to human health and safety, property damage, disease monitoring and agricultural protection.

Josh covers the entire southwest region of Missouri and tasks can include mitigating aggressive Canada geese, beavers chewing trees down, coyotes eating lambs or the topic he will cover today-bears and their love of all things "food."
