GENERATIONS VILLAGE

Join us on Tuesday, January 10 for a special presentation by Jan Furr and Keri McKee, representatives from the new community. Generations Village broke ground on September 15, 2022 in Willard, MO. The community will be the first intergenerational community serving seniors, foster children and foster families in the region. Intergenerational living by design promotes intentional neighboring. The goal is to surround foster children with people who genuinely care about them and strive to see them succeed in life.

Jan Furr and her husband, Tom, are the co-founders of Generations Village. Jan taught English, French, and ESL for 25 years after graduating from Missouri State University with a BS in Education with a French major and an MA in English. Jan is an avid volunteer in the community, serving as the board secretary for Mercy Hospital's Auxiliary, Board Secretary for MO Association of Hospital Auxiliaries, leadership roles within her PEO group, and co-founded Abundant Blessings Ministry for foster families at her church in Nixa.

Keri McKee is a Program Specialist with Missouri's Department of Social Services - Office of Workforce and Community Initiatives. She received her BS in Socio-Political Communications from Missouri State University and is a lifelong resident of the Ozarks. Keri serves as a board member for The Kitchen, Inc Foundation and sits on the Community Outreach committee for Generations Village.
