## "Rotary And Toastmaster"

To help Toastmasters perfect their speaking ability, every meeting has a segment called Table Topics. This is a practice of speaking off-the-cuff about a topic one may or may not have any knowledge of. Once a question is asked, the speaker has a minimum of 1-minute and a maximum of two to give their unprepared response. This exercise helps with extemporaneous speaking and staying within a time limit.

Similar to Rotarians using *The Four-Way Test* as a tool for personal and professional relationships, Table Topics allows a Toastmaster to put what they have learned to practice to become a better communicator.

For today's program, a little will be taken from both of these club practices to test the skills of those participants.

Spend at least 30 minutes thoughtfully reviewing the content of your choice, mindfully applying the Four-Way Test as you review it. Request a Make Up Confirmation (don't forget to send it to Sarah at [rotaryjoplin@gmail.com](mailto:rotaryjoplin@gmail.com)).

### Make it count!

Anytime you participate in something that counts as a make-up, make sure to email Sarah ASAP so it can be entered and counted! Make-ups need to be entered timely. Here is the information to include:

- Function Name
- Function Location
- Function Date
- Which meeting you would like to apply the makeup.
