## HELP NEEDED!



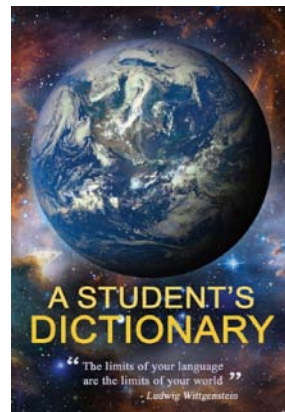
Volunteers Needed Monthly!
