Program: Matt Pinnell - Lieutenant Governor

Matt Pinnell was elected as the 17th Lieutenant Governor of the State of Oklahoma on November 6th, 2018. In that role, he serves as President of the Oklahoma State Senate, and is a member of multiple constitutional boards and commissions. Lt. Governor Pinnell also serves as Secretary of Tourism, Wildlife and Heritage on Governor Kevin Stitt's cabinet.

In his role as Secretary of Tourism, Wildlife and Heritage, Pinnell oversees the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation and the state's efforts to promote tourism, the third largest industry in Oklahoma. Pinnell led the successful effort to rebrand the State of Oklahoma, a component of the overall effort to retain and recruit more jobs to the state of Oklahoma.

David began his full-time career selling real estate in 1982. He is a licensed broker and was with the same company for the 30 years until last year when they were purchased by the largest real estate company in Oklahoma, and the oldest major company in Tulsa, McGraw, Realtors. With many friends and long-time colleagues at McGraw, David enjoys McGraw, Realtors. He has been the Greater Tulsa Association of Realtor's Sales Associate of the Year, and has served as a director for the Greater Tulsa Association of Realtors, the Oklahoma Association of Realtors and Northeast Oklahoma Real Estate Services, Inc. David is a past Trustee of Asbury Church where he plays trumpet and flugelhorn in the New Covenant Orchestra. For many years he played and toured with the gospel big band, Tulsa Praise Orchestra. He has gone on several Asbury men's mission trips to Rio Bravo and Reynosa, Mexico, and has also led men's groups in their home designed to guide men in their walk with Christ.

He currently enjoys riding his high performance Harley, college football, & taking Leslie and the kids and grandsons to the Colorado Rocky Mountains for occasional wilderness camping(but usually renting a nice cabin), fishing, shooting guns, and hiking with their dogs.
