## Program: Major General Glen Moore

Major General Glen Moore enlisted in the Oklahoma Army National Guard in the spring of 1980 while a senior in high school. He shipped off to basic training at Ft Sill Oklahoma a few days after graduating from high school. He completed basic training and Advanced Individual Training (AIT) and was awarded the MOS of 13B, Field Artillery Cannon Crewman.

After a short few years as an enlisted Soldier, he attended Officer Candidate School and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in 1982. MG Moore attended Officer Basic Course at Ft Sill in 1983 where he learned how to be a Field Artillery Officer. MG Moore held various command and staff positions with the Oklahoma Army National Guard including commanding at the Battery, Battalion, and Brigade level. He commanded the 1st Battalion 171st Field Artillery in Altus Oklahoma. After command MG Moore attended the US Army War College in Carlisle PA where he graduated with a Master◆s Degree.

MG Moore was assigned as the commander of the 45th Field Artillery Brigade in March of 2007. In August of 2008 until August of 2009 MG Moore deployed as the Commander of the Brigade in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom where the brigade had Soldiers stationed in Kuwait and Iraq.

MG Moore was promoted to Brigadier General (1 star) in 2011 and was assigned as the Assistant Adjutant General for the Oklahoma Army National Guard. Following this assignment, he was assigned as the Deputy Commanding General, Army National Guard at Fort Sill Oklahoma. He was promoted to Major General in July of 2014 and was assigned as the Deputy Commanding General for the Army◆s Training and Doctrine Command at Fort Eustis, VA.

MG Moore retired after serving the Oklahoma National Guard and United States Army for 38 years. Like most National Guard Soldiers Glen has had dual careers. He is a Tulsa Police Officer and has served with the Police Department for 32 years. Sergeant Moore has served in a variety of positions as a Police Officer including as a patrol officer for several years, vice and narcotics, fugitive warrants detail, and as a member of the Special Operations Team (SWAT) for 20 years. He is currently assigned as the Lieutenant for the Auto Theft Unit of the Detective Division.

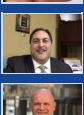
