#### Program: LeadLearnLive Founder Julie Lackey



**Julie Lackey** is the Founder/Executive Director of LeadLearnLive - a non-profit, with the mission of establishing inclusive post-secondary education programs in Oklahoma for students with intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD). Additionally, she works with key collaborators to build a coalition of state support for this (and like) efforts. She has been recognized for her work, most recently receiving the 2018 Catalyst of Change award for Oklahoma from TARC. LeadLearnLive provided the funding to Northeastern State University to begin the RiverHawks Scholar Program, the first fully integrated college program in Oklahoma for students with intellectual or developmental disabilities which began in August of 2018. This is the first of several programs LeadLearnLive plans to fund. When Julie is not serving as wife, mother and community advocate, you can find her at MATRIX Architects and Engineers in the position of Sr. Associate and Director of Interior Design.

Parker is an attorney with 17 years of legal experience. He is the owner and principal of the firm Parker R Smith Attorney at Law PC, where he focuses on estate planning and general business law.

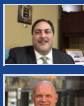

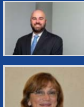

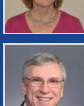

Thanks from me and the Creek County Health Department for everything you guys do.

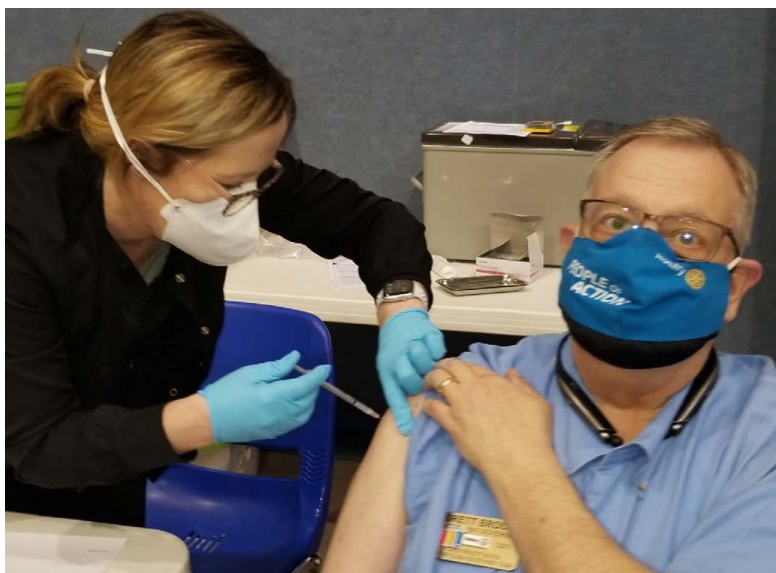

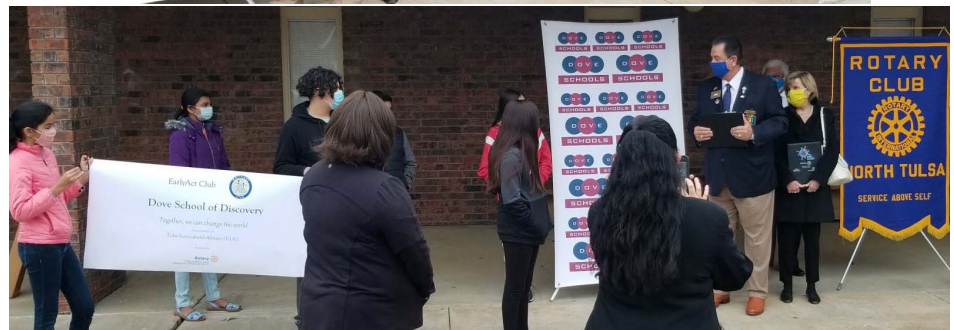
