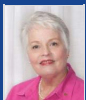

Program: Paul Zachary - Zinc Dam & Pedestrian Bridge

Mr. Zachary is the Director of the City of Tulsa Engineering Services Department and serves as the City Engineer for the City of Tulsa. He is a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Oklahoma and a Certified Floodplain Manager.

His current duties include the oversight of project planning, design, and construction for the City of Tulsa capital improvements program. Mr. Zachary oversees the capital program of civil / municipal projects funded by general obligation bond issues, sales tax, water and wastewater revenue bonds, stormwater revenue bonds, enterprise funds, general fund, grants, Federal Highway & State Transportation funds, and Oklahoma Water Resources Board SRF and FAP funding for the City of Tulsa.

Mr. Zachary was in private practice for 9 years and has worked for the City of Tulsa since 1995. He has served in Development Services, Engineering Services as the Lead Engineer in Stormwater Design, Design Engineering Manager, Deputy Director of Public Works, and now serves in his current capacity. Mr. Zachary is a graduate of Oklahoma State University.

There will be food, but we will only order based on your reservation! Every week we will send an RSVP request to you asking if you will be attending, bringing a guest, and if you and/or your guest will be eating. You can expect meals to range in price between \$13 and \$18 per week, we are currently talking to caterers and food trucks about providing food. More details to come!

Here are Jack's goal for the near term and the year!

- Establish New Recruitment Team, with follow up plan in place;
- Print new membership brochure;
- Add 44 new members for the Rotary Year:
 - 26- Women;
 - 18- Men;
 - More Diversity 25% new members with different ethnic backgrounds;
 - More Veterans 25% new members are veterans or active military;
- Start new mentorship program mentoring new members and getting them engaged by 3rd week
- Establish new orientation program and have quarterly;
- Service project once a month with 50% participation of members;
- Name Tulsa Signature Project;
- Lock down international project and start process by September 1st;
- Purchase Van have it wrapped with:
 - TULSA SOUTHSIDE ROTARY
 - "Rotarians in Action"
 - Find 3-4 sponsors to cover costs of Van wrap
- Find 6 Business to sponsor our lunches to help offset meal costs;
- Have Fellowship calendar rough draft completed by August 1st;
- End of Summer Party at Jack's house date TBD;
- Fundraising Committee finalize projects by August 1st;
- Start Evening meetings once a month;
