Dr. Laura Garrett has a Doctorate of Education in Family Studies and Child Development from Oklahoma State University with a Graduate Certificate in Gerontology. She holds a Master of Human Relations from the University of Oklahoma and a Bachelor's in Consumer Affairs with a Secondary Major in Gerontology from Kansas State University. She currently serves as an Assistant Professor of Psychology at Tulsa Community College. Prior to that, she served as an administrator for a non-profit retirement community in Oklahoma City. She serves as a Community Educator for the State Alzheimer's Association. She was a member of the Oklahoma Aging Advocacy Leadership Academy in 2017. Dr. Garrett has completed training as a certified dementia practitioner and with the Eden Associate training. Her mother passed away after living with dementia for several years. Her daughter Sarah is a graduate student at Washington State University and her son, Robert is a junior at the University of Southern California. She is a frequent speaker in aging and generational issues.

Her Rotary career includes being a Past President, past Assistant Governor, and she currently serves as the Youth Services Chair for District 6110. She is an active member of Tulsa Sunrise.

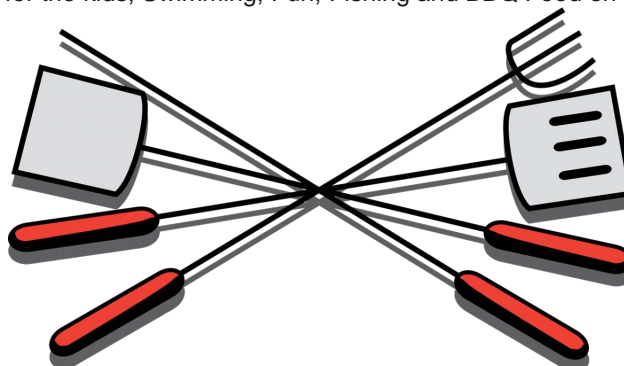
