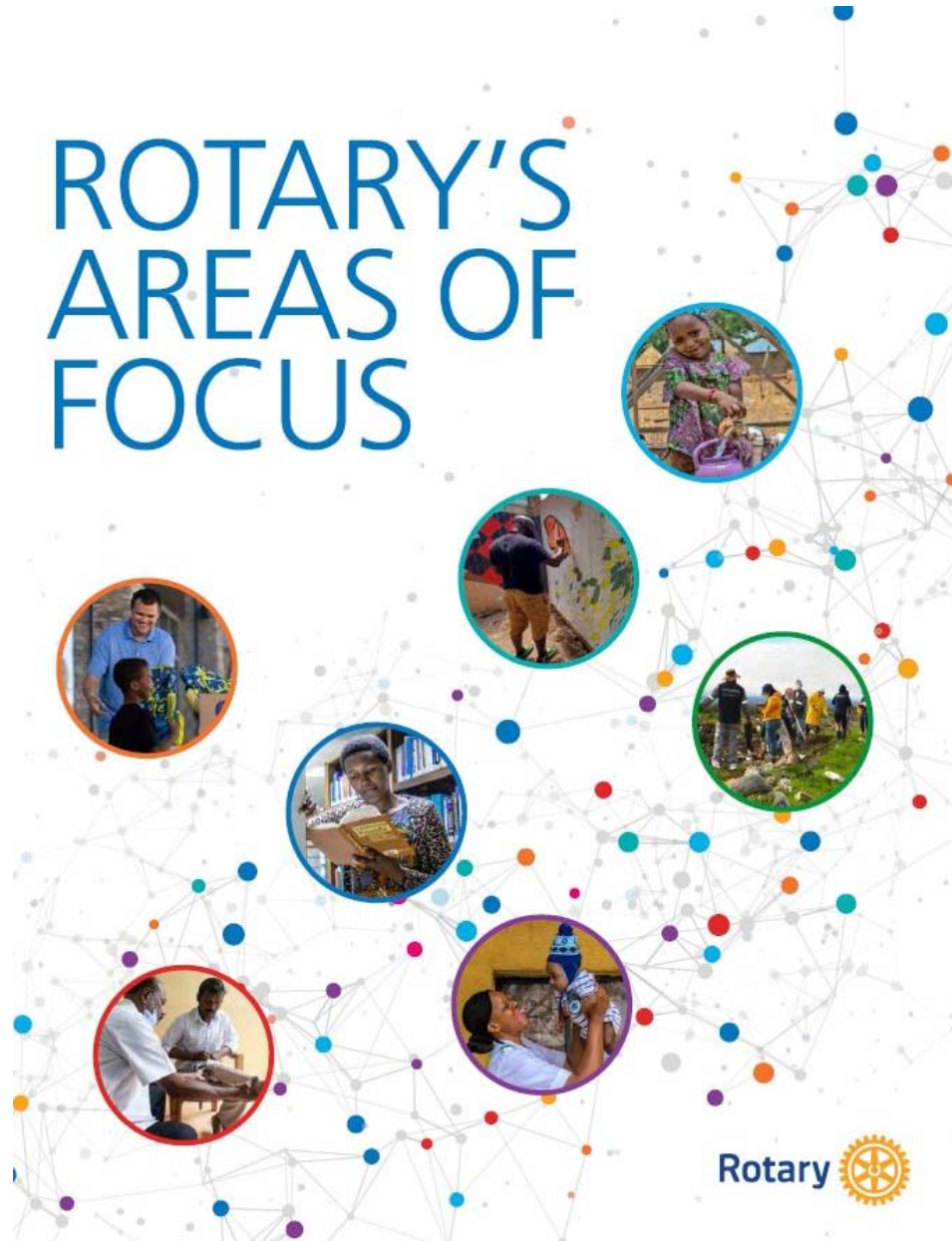

District Nominating Committee

The district nominating committee is accepting nominations for District Governor-nominee designate, who will serve as the district governor in 2026-27. Each club can suggest one person if there is a candidate from your club that would be willing to serve in that Rotary year. Instructions have been emailed to each club President and Assistant Governor on how to submit your club's nomination. All forms must be mailed by December 1, 2023.

Club Secretaries - Has your club's meeting place or time changed? Any other club information changed? Make sure you update DACdb with the new information. If so, go to admin functions and edit club to make the updates.

IRS' Annual Filing Requirement

Whether your club is a subordinate under Rotary International's 501(c)(4) group exemption or is independently tax-exempt, the IRS requires that all Rotary clubs in the U.S. and its territories file an annual information return. For those clubs whose tax year follows the Rotary year, the deadline to file is 15 November. The form a club must file is dependent upon its gross receipts for the year.
