This Week's Program - February 23, 2021

What do you want your Rotary Club to be?

Today's meeting will be led by Former District Governor Nancy Leonhardt.

Below are the instructions for our Visioning Session on Tuesday, February 23rd.

Zoom only allows 10 options for each poll. Due to the large number of diverse responses in most categories (which is awesome!), most of our 9 polls will have 3 parts, an A, a B, and a C. Please carefully read the following instructions so that you accurately vote on the items you want.



1. Attached are the poll questions and options to vote on. If possible, print them out so that you can highlight the items you want to vote on and be prepared to vote at the meeting. If you are not able to print it out, be sure to write down which items you want to vote on. Some of your votes may be in Part B or Part C of a question.
2. You are limited to only **THREE** choices in each poll question. That includes polls with 3 parts (an A, B and C). For example, For question #1, what does your club stand for, Poll #1A has 10 items related to that question, Poll #1B has 10 items, and Poll #1C has 10 items, for a total of 30 items. You can only vote for 3 of the 30. Yes, this is a challenge!
3. For each question, we will show Part A first, allow time to vote on those items, and then show Part B for those who have items in Part B to vote on, and then Part C for those items you wish to vote on.
4. After the voting is complete, I will tell the story of what your club will be celebrating in the Year 2024.
5. Please note that the meeting will begin at 12:00pm sharp. We will need the entire hour to conduct this visioning session.

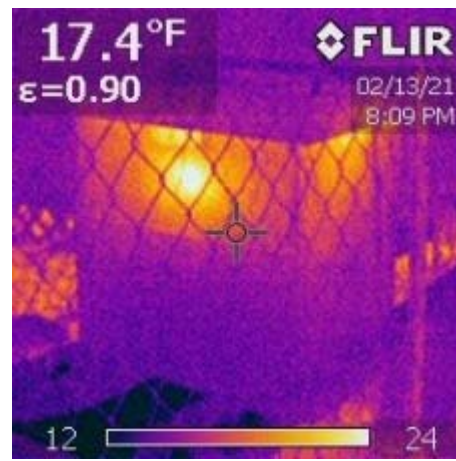

Feb 16, 2021 47th Online Meeting Adria Hyde - Stars Foundation & World Orphans Day

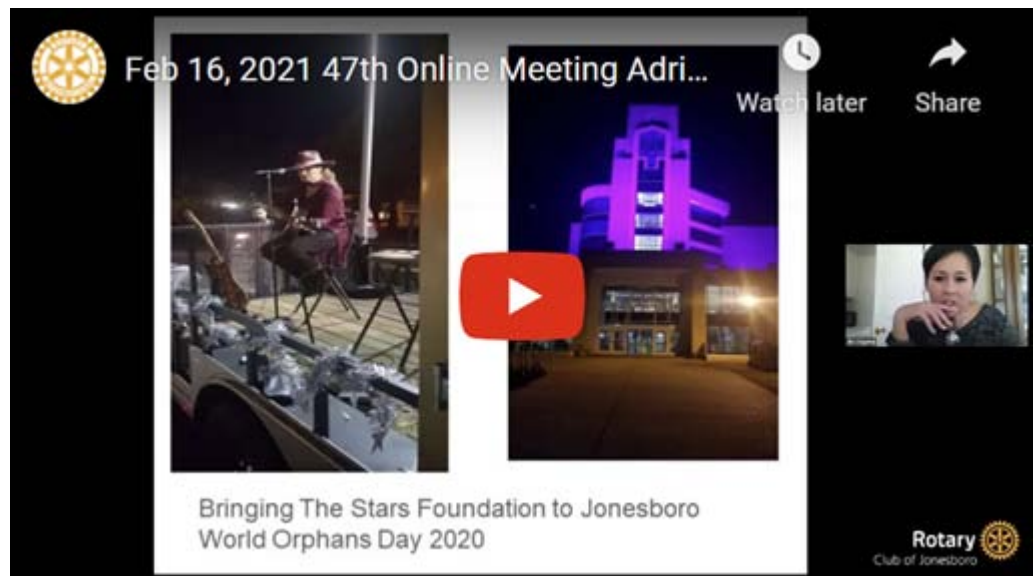
