Empower has 4,000 miles of fiber optics and services over 13,000 customers. Why? It is reliable, its customer service is held to the highest standards, it has the lowest prices, it has no contract, and it has no setup fees. Empower is available to Craighead Electric customers and some others.

The Internet is taking over cable with its streaming options. Many of these options are free. Some can be shared. There are no contracts, You don't pay for channels you don't watch. You can try services for free.

Some people have replaced cable television with streaming options. These usually come at a lower cost than cable.
