Doug White, President and General Manager, Arkansas State Fair

Doug White is president and general manager of the Arkansas Livestock Show Association, also known as the Arkansas State Fairgrounds. Doug assumed his role in December of 2018 and manages the day-to-day operations at the fairgrounds, which hosts a variety of events year round. By far the biggest event at the fairgrounds is the annual state fair.

This year marks the 80th State Fair and promises to continue with the tradition of offering family-friendly, safe and secure entertainment for its patrons. Livestock and agriculture remain a focus for this year's fair. Each year, the state fairgrounds provides over \$140,000 in scholarships and incentives for the youth in our state.

Prior to his position at the Arkansas fairgrounds, Doug was vice president of systems services for Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation (AECC) and Arkansas Electric Cooperatives, Inc. (AECI), both headquartered in Little Rock. He was responsible for the conception, development, implementation and measurement of the marketing and communications functions for the organization on behalf of its owner systems.

Doug has over twenty-five years experience in the electric utility and cooperative industry. Doug holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Oklahoma and has completed coursework toward a master's degree in Linguistics from Oklahoma State University.

Doug has served in leadership positions on a variety of industry task forces and committees. His work in the advertising and marketing fields have won numerous Addys, as well as Best of Show both regionally and nationally. Doug is currently a member of Rotary Club 99 and has served on the boards of the Better Business Bureau, the Baptist Health Foundation Bolo Bash committee, the Ronald McDonald House of Central Arkansas and the Arkansas Independent Colleges Foundation.

Doug and his wife Tonya have five children and reside in White Hall.
