Theba Lolley, a longtime Little Rock resident, has served in community relations since 1997 at CBS affiliate THV11, and most recently, as guest co-host for the station's popular lifestyle program, The Vine. Over the last two years, she has become a self-taught storyteller, leading THV11's franchise Discover Arkansas, and tells myriad feature stories along the way. All of Theba's stories are shot via iPhone with the help of other specialized gadgets. In addition, she shoots and produces THV11's Discover Arkansas segments with host Ashley King. In recent years, Theba has gained a following of new and old friends through social media, and now The Vine, with her thoughtful, candid ways she has shared her experiences caring for her parents, each battling forms of Alzheimer's. Her father has since passed away, but Theba continues to care for her mother, Barbara. She is an advocate for Aging and Alzheimer's awareness with regular segments called Theba's Tips on The Vine.

Betsy Broyles Arnold, Founder, The Frank and Barbara Broyles Foundation, Betsy's passion is to provide caregivers with the necessary tools and game plan to give them confidence and hope during this season of their lives. Betsy leads local support groups and works with caregivers one-on-one across the country.

When Betsy learned her mother, Barbara Broyles, was diagnosed with Alzheimer's, she and her family moved from Texas to Fayetteville, AR to be a primary caregiver alongside her twin sister, Linda. This experience changed her and her family forever. After her mother passed, Betsy and her father, Coach Frank Broyles, were inspired to share the knowledge they gained with others.

Combining the latest research with their own experiences as a caregiving daughter and spouse, respectively, they produced the Coach Broyles' Playbook for Alzheimer's Caregivers. There are more than 1 million books in print and it has been translated into 11 languages.

Over the last 12+ years of this mission, Betsy has devoted her life to helping caregivers. Betsy and Molly have traveled all over the United States giving more than 170 speeches to different organizations and appearing on more than 400 TV and radio shows, with a total reach exceeding 30 million households.

As the need to help caregivers continues to grow, Betsy knows her work helps provide a valuable resource to the countless families affected by dementia including Alzheimer's. Now, Betsy looks to increase the reach and awareness of the foundation with her family by her side.

Kenneth Morgan Sauer, MD is a family practice doctor with Baptist Health Comprehensive Care Clinic. He specializes in geriatric medicine and pain management. Dr. Sauer graduated from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences College of Medicine in 2000.

Kirsten Dickins is the Executive Director of the Alzheimer's Association's Arkansas Chapter which serves all 75 counties in the state. As the leading voluntary health association in Alzheimer's care, support and research, the Alzheimer's Association works partners with volunteers, businesses, health systems and public officials in chapters across the country to serve those battling Alzheimer's disease and all other dementia.
