Terry C. Hartwick, Mayor City of North Little Rock

Mayor Terry C. Hartwick was elected in 2020 as the Mayor of the City of North Little Rock, for a second time, following over four decades of leadership in public service and the business community.

Born and raised in North Little Rock, he is a graduate of North Little Rock High School. He attended the University of Central Arkansas, served in the United States Air Force, and is a Veteran of Foreign Wars.

In 1984, he was elected Mayor of the City of North Little Rock, serving until 1989.

In 2001, he became President and CEO of the North Little Rock Chamber of Commerce, where he served for 15 years. With his focus on helping small businesses grow and succeed, it soon became the third largest Chamber in the State of Arkansas. He worked closely with the City on several projects including the relocation of the Arkansas Travelers to North Little Rock with the development of Dickey-Stephens ballpark. He also initiated the Arkansas Women's Hall

of Fame.

In January 2016, Mayor Hartwick was appointed as Director of the North Little Rock Parks and Recreation Department by Mayor Joe A. Smith where he was able to continue fulfilling his passion for public service. By adding new rental facilities, upgrading indoor and outdoor public recreation facilities, and creating the all-inclusive One Heart Playground, he continued to help improve quality of life in his hometown.

Since being elected again in 2020, Mayor Hartwick continues to enthusiastically serve all of North Little Rock by encouraging economic growth and strengthening and uniting communities.
