80 Years of Workforce Development at UA-Pulaski Tech College (UA-PTC) Summer DeProw, Ph.D., Chancellor

Founded in October 1945 as the Little Rock Vocational School, UA-PTC has evolved over the past 80 years into a cornerstone of workforce development, playing a vital role in supporting the state's economic growth. In February 2017, the institution became part of the University of Arkansas System, marking a new chapter in its history. Join us as **Chancellor Summer DeProw** reflects on the school's rich history, highlights recent achievements, and shares her vision for the future of UA-PTC.





Dr. Summer DeProw began serving as Chancellor at the University of Arkansas Pulaski Technical College on Jan. 2, 2023. Previously, she served as UA-PTC's Provost and before arriving at UA-PTC, Dr. DeProw served as Assistant Vice Chancellor for Assessment and Accreditation at Arkansas State University (A-State) in Jonesboro. She had been with A-State for six years and started as the Director of Assessment. She was promoted to Assistant Vice Chancellor after two years in the Director's position.

She has a strong background working with international and other diverse student populations. In 2014, DeProw graduated from the University of Mississippi's (UM) doctoral program in Higher Education, where she researched student intercultural competence development, postsecondary education systems in South Africa, and the history of faculty participation in campus integration during the US Civil Rights era. Dr. DeProw was named outstanding doctoral student by the University of Mississippi's School of Education.

During her career at Williams Baptist University, she instructed and mentored many international students from Asia, Africa, Europe, and Central and South America, as well as a multitude of historically disadvantaged domestic students. DeProw served for 18 years as Business Department Chair at Williams Baptist University and earned Associate Professor rank.

In addition to her post-graduate work, Dr. DeProw holds a Bachelor's degree in accounting, an MBA, and a Specialist in Community College Teaching from A-State. DeProw has served higher education since 1997 and, throughout her career, has mentored hundreds of students, developed curriculum and programs, coached national award-winning collegiate teams, participated in economic and workforce development, and served many faculty and staff.

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May 20: Battle of Fallujah 20th Anniversary, Dr. Jamie Griffin, Head of School, Episcopal Collegiate

Dr. Jamie Griffin, Head of Episcopal Collegiate School, will share his remarkable story as an aircraft maintenance officer with Marine All-Weather Attack Squadron 242, the "Bats," during their historic 2004-2005 deployment to Iraq. Stationed at Al-Asad Airbase, the Bats maintained a record-setting operational tempo, flying F/A-D Hornets, delivering over 8,000 flight hours and 400,000 pounds of precision ordnance in support of coalition forces, including critical air support during Operation Phantom Fury's Second Battle of Fallujah and Iraq's first democratic elections in January 2005.

The talk goes beyond military history - it's a compelling exploration of leadership, resilience, and teamwork under pressure. Jamie will share insights from this award-winning deployment, honored as "Marine Fighter Squadron of the Year" in 2005, and share strategic lessons that continue to guide his leadership in education today. Whether you're inspired by aviation, history, or practical leadership strategies applicable to any field, this presentation will captivate and inspire.
