

Kickin' It with the Little Rock Rangers

Soccer is big, and the Little Rock Rangers have been a key part of the popularity growth in Central Arkansas. Join us as we learn more about Little Rock's only semi-professional league and the growth of so Matt Jones, next week's panel will feature Jonathan Wardlaw, president and general manager of the Rangers, Nick Doyle, head coach, and Ante Jazic, technical director for the Rangers. The Little Rock Rangers Soccer Club, an American soccer team, was founded in 2016 and played its inaugural season in 2016. The Rangers play in the USL League Two, a national semi-professional league Memorial Stadium in Little Rock.

The Little Rock Rangers were accepted to play in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL) in 2015. In 2018, the Rangers had a 7â€"3 season and qualified for the 2019 Open Cup, "the nation's oldes 2021. The team mostly consists of high school and college-aged players, therefore the team is entirely amateur in order to preserve the college players' NCAA eligibility. The Little Rock Rangers Soccer Club i certarla Arkansas area by bringing in top-quality players and coaches. The Little Rock Rangers Academy, run by the club, provides opportunities for children ages 1 to 18 to develop their soccer skills with coac soccer club scholarships to underprivileged but motivated children in the area through extra revenue from ticket sales and donations received.









Matt Jones

Matt Jones, former star quarterback at the University of Arkansas, grew up in Van Buren and had a standout high school career in football and basketball before being recruited to play for Arkansas for the 200 time starting quarterback from 2002 -2004. He was also a two-year letterman in basketball at Arkansas, appearing in 28 games in his career. Jones was drafted in the 2005 NFL Draft by the Jacksonville Jagu

During his freshman season at Arkansas in 2001, Jones led the Razorbacks to a thrilling seven-overtime win against Ole Miss. In 2002, Matt led Arkansas to a share of the SEC Western Division Championst pass to Decori Birmingham in the closing seconds of the season finale against LSU has become known by most Arkansans as "The Miracle on Markham.†In 2003, Jones led Arkansas to another seven seasons.

In 2022, Matt joined the on-air team at ESPN Arkansas as co-host of Halftime with Phil Elson. He also appears on other programs and podcasts produced by ESPN Arkansas.

Jonathan Wardlaw

Jonathan Wardlaw is a Little Rock native, entrepreneur and founder of the Little Rock Rangers. In addition to serving as president and general manager of the Little Rock Rangers USL2 team, he is also co-ow Arkansas' Landscape Architecture program and played competitive soccer growing up.

Nick Doyle

Nick Doyle is the new head coach for the Little Rock Rangers USL League Two Men's team but has been involved in the Rangers program since its inception as a player, Club Captain from 2016-2023, a Africa, but played college soccer in Conway and is married to an Arkansan. Nick is also currently soccer assistant coach at Hendrix College.

Ante Jazie

Ante Jazic is technical director for the Rangers program and a Rangers Academy co-owner. Ante retired from professional soccer after a career as a 10-year starter in the European Leagues followed by seve the European leagues, he played for teams in Croatia, Austria and Russia. In the U.S., he played for the LA Galaxy and for Chivas USA. A native Canadian from Nova Scotia, Ante is a former captain and men and they have three children.
