The sculpture will soon be on display in the museum at the Central High School National Historic Site. It's going to be a terrific way to honor their legacy and celebrate the role everyone had in that special award!

And when our community faced the aftermath of the devastating March tornadoes, our club stepped up and donated more than \$20,000 through our Little Rock Tornado Relief Fund.

We also launched our Illuminate the Rock effort to light the Veterans Memorial Bridge.
