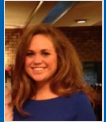

Wendy Ellis Jones, Development for Athletics at UA-Little Rock

Dr. Ellis Jones is no stranger to Higher Education and Collegiate Athletics. She started her career coaching track at the collegiate level. Prior to relocating to Arkansas a month ago from south Florida, she served as the Vice President of Operations for Honey Shine under the Alonzo Mourning Foundation. She was the Assistant Director of Marketing in Athletics & Recreation at Northwestern University, and the Executive Director for one of the largest urban YMCA's on the south side of Chicago. She was instrumental in helping launch the first professional (WNBA) team "Chicago Sky" and spearheaded the national campaign for the Go Girl Go campaign with the Women's Sports Foundation.

While much of her background has been in collegiate athletics, professional sports and non-profit, she is very passionate about the advancement of women leaders in sports, youth development and especially working with disadvantaged girls. Coming from a humble beginning, Wendy always saw herself as a winner, given the number of races she won growing up in her neighborhood. From her very first track meet, she believed that she was a champion and she went on to prove it by becoming an All-American track star. Capitalizing on her lightning speed, she set records in the 1990s which remain to this day. She is a four-time conference Champion in the 400 meters, a nine-time All-American, and a 2014 Athletic Hall of Fame Inductee. She has also been recognized as a Woman of Influence in Chicago, and Miami and a Prominent & Influential Black woman in Business by Legacy Magazine, a Miami-Based magazine.

Her unwavering work ethic, positive self-talk and unyielding drive to succeed, No Matter What - has allowed Wendy to shatter glass ceilings and overcome all setbacks. She holds a master's degree in Sport Administration and a doctorate in Education, with a concentration in Ethical Leadership. Dr. Ellis Jones believes that everyone should dream BIG and strive to achieve greatness. When she is not out meeting new people in her new community, she spends time with her husband Dr. Preston Jones and her 2-year-old Yorkie Shuri.
