#### Rotary International Dues

Rotary International will email your club's Treasurer the Semi-Annual Dues invoice by the end of January. Clubs are required to pay the balance upon receipt of the invoice. Make sure your Treasurer has been reported to RI. This invoice is based off the number of Active Members on file with Rotary International.

Want to view the RI January 2024 Invoice or past invoices? Authorized club officers can view &/or pay an invoice online. These are Club President, Secretary, Executive Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Chair or Rotary Foundation Chair. Simply log in to My Rotary. Click Manage > Club & District Administration > Club Administration > Club Invoice.

#### 2024-2025 Club Officers - DACdb Update Needed

There are still several clubs that haven't added their officers for 2024-2025 to DACdb. President Elects must be entered into DACdb so they can receive MAPETs communications. Go to My Club tab and take Admin Functions then Edit Club Positions from the left-hand menu to update.

#### Club Recognition Criteria is Due

The deadline for club recognition criteria is March 1. This means the Governors' Banner & Club of the Year information must be updated in DACdb by then. In DACdb go to the District Tab and Select the Awards Criteria Icon. Work with your Assistant Governor to make sure everything is completed and updated on time.
