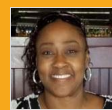

HSV Rotary Spring Grant Cycle

It's time for the HSV Rotary Grant spring cycle. Grant funding is available this spring for eligible nonprofits that meet the guidelines. The grant applications are available online at the Hot Springs Village Rotary Club website. Grant applications will be accepted from February 1 through March 31, 2021. The grant committee will then review and rank all the applications based on merit, and the recipients will be announced by May 1. The criteria are listed on the application form, and

each grant request must be sponsored by a Rotarian, and if one is not listed by the applicant, a club member will be assigned as a sponsor. There are so many worthwhile organizations in need, so please share this information with people and organizations that would be eligible and could benefit from assistance by receiving a grant from Rotary!
