**Club Operations -**

- Members paid \$700 for dues and the Satellite Club reimbursed us \$729 for their RI dues
- Happy dollars totaled \$105 and raffle ticket sales totaled \$299
- We had \$5 in merchandise sales and \$220 in quarterly donations to The Rotary Foundation
- We purchased one blue badge for \$17.47
- We made our semi-annual donations to the Imagination Libraries of the two counties, \$75 each
- Meeting expenses in February were \$328.80
- Someone ran off with the raffle jackpot of \$3,413
- We spent \$31.31 on office supplies and \$65 on our final month of rent for the Balboa Drive Storage locker
- Ended the month with \$16,768.36 in the bank

- Reserve account earned \$0.23 interest
- Received a \$23.07 donation from Amazon Smiles
