David Schleuse ♦ Had stents put in this last Sunday morning. He said Went great! See you in the morning!

Connie Shoemaker ♦ Friday Connie fell backwards from their front step landing on the back of her head on the tile. She blacked out and had nausea and head pain for a few minutes. With Bob ♦s help she got up and went to Convenient Care. She was told to go to hospital if several symptoms occurred. After about 24 hours she realized she had injured her tail bone making it difficult to get around. She is still moving slow, thus not in attendance this morning.

Mike Medica ♦ I told you last week that Mike fell down a flight of stairs to their basement and broke 2 vertebrae in his neck. He will be in a C-Collar for 6 weeks. I spoke with Sharon last night and last Thursday night she had to call 911 to come get Mike he was in such pain. Doctor admitted Mike to the hospital concerned that he had not been able to tolerate his dialysis for several days. Little known fact. If you cannot sit up in the dialysis center for your dialysis, which Mike could not do for the pain, you cannot get dialysis. So yesterday the kidney doctor sent Mike to CHI rehab across the street for rehab and so Mike could get the dialysis treatments. He can lay down there. While there he will also go through physical therapy and occupational therapy so he can dress himself, learn to shower and bathe with the collar, etc. His pain is better. As only Mike can do the bright side is ♦♦. ♦the beds sure are more comfortable in the rehab center. ♦ I told Sharon I would ask you all to double down on prayers. She goes once a day because they keep him so busy.

Greg Pederson ♦ (Melanie ♦s husband) ♦ has been diagnosed with prostate cancer. The meeting with the surgeon is scheduled for May 10 th to determine the next step. Prayers that the cancer has not spread.

Larry Wilson ♦ Larry e-mailed, ♦Went for MRI and I was in so much pain I could not tolerate the MRI. It is rescheduled for the 19th. They have prescribed a painkiller for me to take before the MRI. in a better place before returning.💎
