# **Helping Entrepreneurs - Jeff Standridge**



Today's speaker, Jeff Standridge - the Managing Director of Conductor in Conway, AR - was introduced by Rotarian Mark Graham.

Jeff Standridge presented information and available resources for those who want to start a small business. He and his wife feel right at home when in Hot Springs, since Jeff is originally from Glenwood and his wife grew up in Hot Springs. They now reside in Conway. Jeff was a featured speaker at Jeff Farris Leadership Academy.

Conductor was created by a partnership between the University of Central Arkansas and Startup Junkie. These two organizations saw that entrepreneurs and innovators weren't getting the help they deserved in central Arkansas. They are focused on innovation, entrepreneurship, talent development, and economic empowerment.

Since launching in 2016, Conductor has provided resources and knowledge to hundreds of small business owners and reached thousands of people through Conductor events. All are invited to join the community of entrepreneurs, friends, and mentors. Entrepreneurs make up a large portion of employers and employees. Small business owners make up 99% of all employers and 50% of employees work for them. Conductor provides access to expertise, an ecosystem where ideas can be shared, and access to capital.

Conductor also provides one-on-one consultants, 0% interest business loans, they provide a connection to local business leaders, training and networking, and advocate for

## **Rotary Minute**



Rotarian Robert Zunick presented the following Rotary Minute:

News about an outbreak of polio in the Gaza Strip hit the news last week, and it made it abundantly clear that the war on polio is not over. Rotary adopted eradicating polio as its central mission in 1988 and has reduced cases by 99.9% since then. The World Health Organization announced an ambitious mass vaccination campaign in the war-torn Gaza Strip after the first case in 25 years was discovered in an 11-year-old boy who is now completely paralyzed. In this campaign, 640,000 children will be vaccinated - 180,000 have been vaccinated so far. Rotary provides funding for the fight against polio in other areas of

the world that need support as desperately as it is currently needed in the Gaza Strip. Gaza is receiving immediate assistance because of the news coverage.
