While in college, she interned at the Smithsonian's National Museum of American History and discovered how much she enjoys preserving history and presenting it to the public.

After college, she worked with Alaska Native entities in Alaska as a VISTA volunteer, then as a National Park Service Museum Technician and Archaeologist trainee. That work eventually led her to Arizona State University to earn her Graduate degree in history and a certificate in public history.



Pam moved to Louisiana in 2005 to be the local history and public outreach specialist at the Bossier Parish Libraries History Center. She enjoys researching, writing about, and presenting programs to all ages, especially on less-explored aspects of Bossier Parish history, such as the African-American schools of Bossier Parish and their teachers. She writes a weekly local history column for the Bossier Press Tribune.
