

## APRIL 4, 2024 GUEST SPEAKER SCOTT LAVERGNE

Our speaker this week will be Scott Lavergne on the topic of Artificial Intelligence, and it's impact on society.

Scott Lavergne is the Chief Executive officer for Enterprise Data Concepts (EDC), which is a technology support company with offices in Lafayette and New Orleans. He co-founded his first IT company, Datastream Inc., a software development and technology support company, in 1999. In 2001, he split from his partner and founded EDC. In 2012, Scott opened his New Orleans location with the goal of supporting businesses in all of south Louisiana. EDC specializes in technology support for the legal, insurance, and medical industries. Over his



decades in the IT support industry, Scott has helped businesses transition multiple technology shifts from cloud, virtualization, and now artificial intelligence (AI).

Scott holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette in computer science. He is a long-time member of the Rotary Club of Lafayette and a past president. He is currently on the boards of the Better Business Bureau of Acadiana, Foundation for Wellness, and Cypremort Yacht Club. Previously, Scott worked with the Evangeline Area Council BSA with roles in the pack, troop and district level.

Scott has been married to Melanie for 27 years, and they have two children, Nathan (26) and Thomas (23).

# Recap of March 28, 2024 Program - Mr. Al Patin, CEO of Oschner Lafayette General Medical Center

Mr. Al Patin, CEO of Ochsner Lafavette General Medical Center, began his presentation by providing background information on his career in the medical field. The mission of OLGMC is to serve. heal, lead, educate and innovate, which was observed in a video that featured services. provided to a patient. Mr. Patin presented an overview and highlights of Ochsner's current state (patients served, number of hospitals, locations of facilities, etc.) Since its merger with Lafayette General Medical Center, the OLGMC facility has added more resources and technology and has been recognized by US News and World Report as a Best Regional Hospital in 2023-24. As a major teaching hospital, the facility provides a Graduate Medical Education residency program and an accelerated option for nursing students.
