**August 18, 2022 Speaker - Raymond Hebert,
Executive Director, Community Foundation of Acadiana**



Raymond Hébert is the CEO of Community Foundation of Acadiana (CFA). He has served in this capacity since the Foundation's inception in 2000. Mr. Hébert is a St. Martinville native and earned a B.A. in History and a Minor in Philosophy from St. Joseph Seminary College in Covington, Louisiana where he served as Vice-President and President of the Student Government Association. Mr. Hébert has been

involved with several community organizations and currently serves on the Boards of Directors of One Acadiana, St. Joseph Seminary College Alumni Association, the William C. Schumacher Family Foundation, the Advisory Board of Catholic Vitality 360, the Louisiana Bar Association's Acadiana Community Partnership Panel, and the Ochsner's Healthy State Advisory Board. He served on Boards of the Acadian Memorial Foundation, the Louisiana Association of Nonprofit Organizations (LANO), and Regions Bank South Louisiana Advisory Board. Mr. Hébert is a graduate of Leadership Lafayette XXI, inducted into The Daily Advertiser Business Hall of Fame, and invited to participate in Chevron's Management Institute. Mr. Hébert is married to Allyson Trahan; they are the parents of three children - Olivia, Amelia, and Camille.

Community Foundation of Acadiana's (CFA) Core Purpose is to build legacies and improve communities by connecting all generous people to the causes they care about. CFA has realized more than \$345 million in philanthropic activities since inception in 2000 and currently has assets of more than \$200 million. CFA's donor-directed grant distributions now exceed \$180 million. While donors are not limited geographically, CFA's primary service area includes the parishes of Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermilion. In 2018, CFA established the William C. Schumacher Family Foundation, a Supporting Organization of CFA. CFA is the third largest community foundation in the state and has been recognized in the Top 100 U.S. community foundations. These important milestones ensure CFA's position as one of Louisiana's premier philanthropic organizations.
