
Shipyard Tours is a major fundraiser for the club, so please share this information with friends and associates.

Bob's wife Mary Nickel, High School Principal Keith Nervey and Jason Palmer shared the planned legacy to Bob and the high school auditorium.






Mike Felhoefer and Thad Birmingham were remembered for the set designs in a few of the plays. They, on the other hand, have been touched since then.
