-Humilitarian reviewed birthdays and anniversary dates and applied appropriate fines.

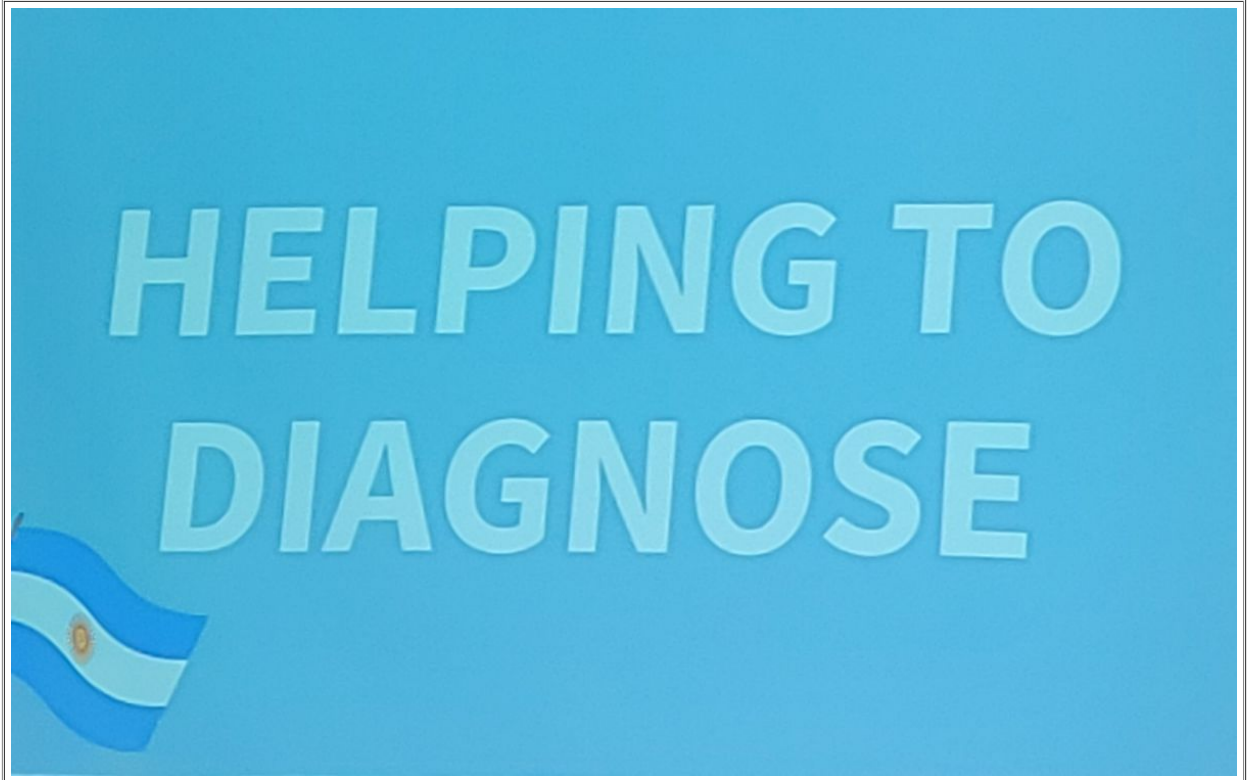

After multiple visits to the medical facilities in her district, Ophelia became involved with local Argentinian physicians and Rotary Clubs to purchase an updated Eko Cardiograph unit to replace the single dated unit on site. Of the \$40M required, \$25M has been raised by local Rotary Clubs.

Ophelia has arranged meetings with 8 NE WI Rotary Clubs and several Lions Clubs to present the project and request support.

Her presentation resulted in an active club discussion on the potential for support. The Board meets next Thursday and will include it in the agenda. It was also suggested a Rotary District joint project with the Argentinian Clubs involved.

Truly a remarkable project with a strong personal commitment from Ophelia. She was very complimentary of the opportunity Rotary had provided for the exchange.
