



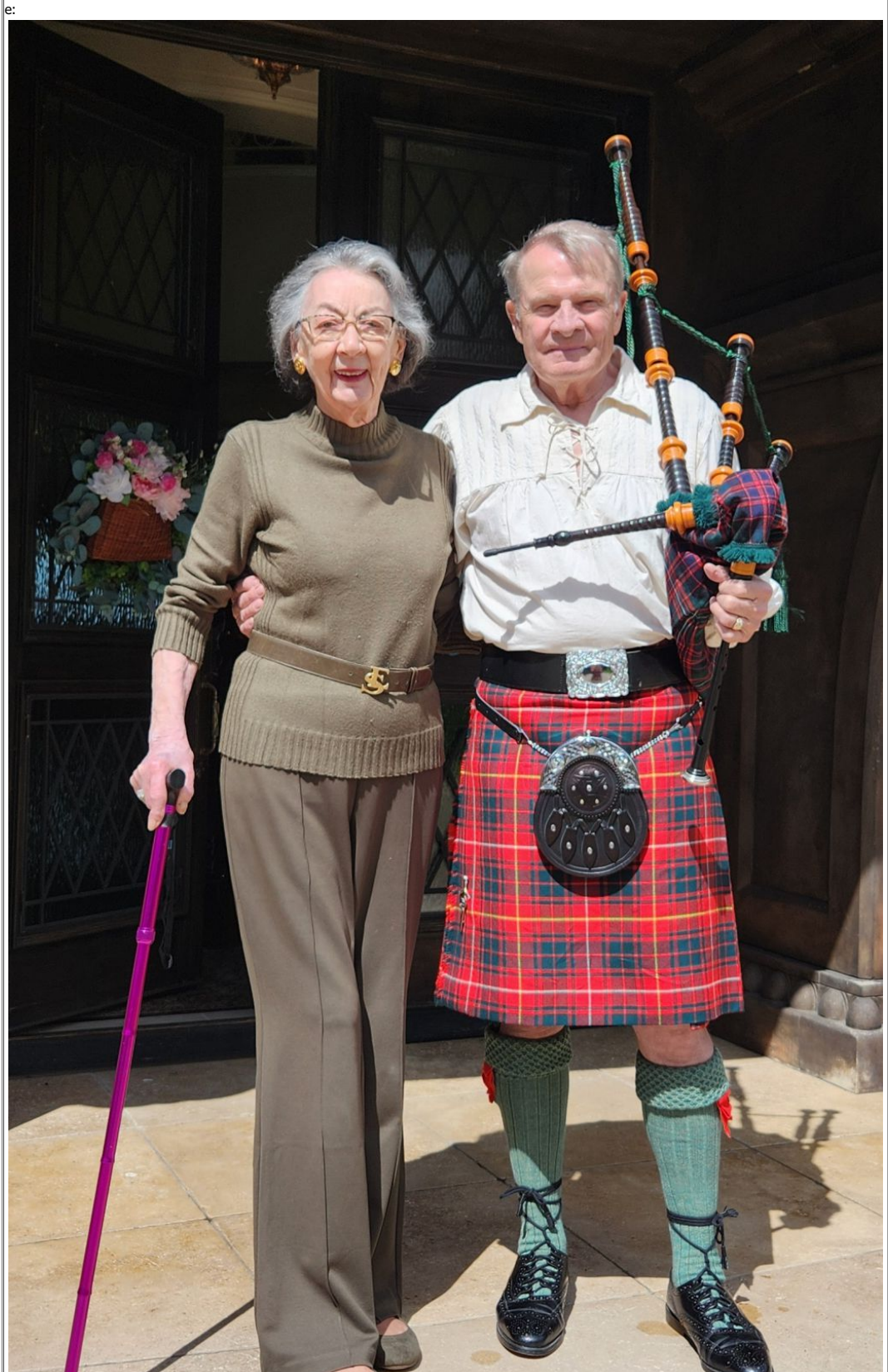
Rotary This Week-May 2, 2024
