Rotary Board Highlights:

- Rotary past outbound exchange student **Ophelia Linnan** (Sean and Christy's daughter) returned from Argentina this past summer with a passion to assist the local Rotary chapter in Argentina raise funds for an eco-cardiogram machine. This badly needed device is not presently available to the local clinic. She is leading an effort to raise \$8,000 in association with several WI Rotary clubs and the Rotary Club in Argentina. The board approved \$1000 to provide matching funds and create a hub for additional club support.
- **Tonya Feldhofer**, Rotary Interact Co-ordinator (with **Alyson Fleck**) announced the Rotary Interact Club is also considering a donation to **Ophelia Linnan's** project.
- Meeting attendance is a key goal of the club this year. Various efforts are being initiated to honor members with strong attendance. President **Amy** reminded everyone to sign the attendance sheet at the entrance table. A real strength of Rotary is making lifetime friends via meeting attendance.
- **Dacdb** is the official web-site of Rotary International and a major tool in information exchange within the club. As the site expands its functionality, the ability to donate funds directly has been added. To clarify to members, the small service fee will be applied directly to the person creating the transaction. More to this service to come.

The Rotary International Dinner was a great success with over 40 people in attendance. This dinner was started in 1993, but needed refreshing after the Covid interruption. **Christina Trepani**, owner of **Door County Candle**, shared her story of generating several million dollars for Ukrainian charitable relief. Rotary provided a \$1000 from the Charitable Trust to support those efforts.

Although hard to read, attached was the list of Outbound and Inbound students.

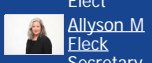
