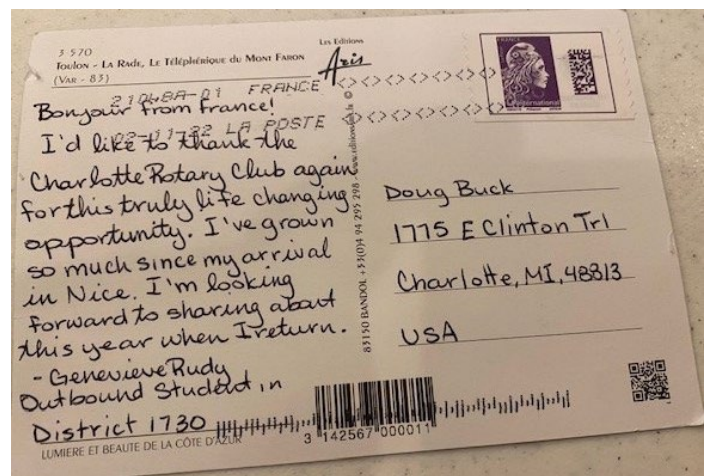
50/50: **Tim Reed** sold the winning \$30 ticket to **Barbara Fulton**
