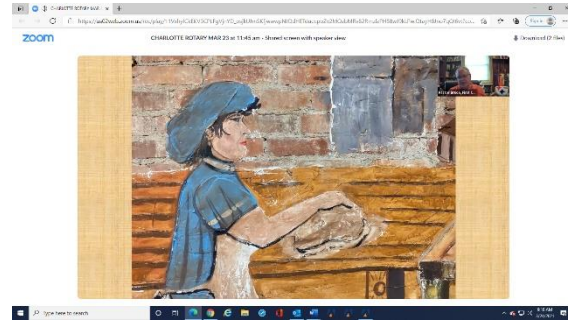

Internet Hacking has become a major problem over the last few years. 43% of cyberattacks are aimed at small businesses that don't have procedures set up for protection. 85 is the average number of passwords per employee in a small business, 13 times is the average reuse of the same password and 80% of breaches are linked to passwords.
