TREES OF REMEMBRANCE CEREMONY



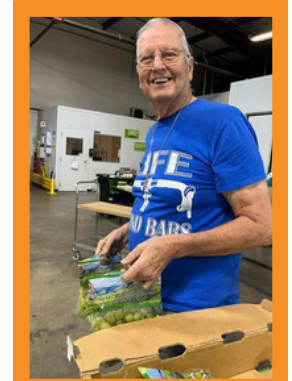
