World Polio Update As of 9/26/24

Four more cases of wild poliovirus caused paralysis were confirmed this week--all from Pakistan but zero positive environmental samples.

Wild Poliovirus Cases reported this year: Forty (40)â€™19 in Afghanistan & 21 in Pakistan.

Onset most recent wild poliovirus cases: Afghanistan: 08/10/24
Pakistan: 09/05/24
