World Polio Update

As of 10/31/24

Two more cases of wild poliovirus caused paralysis were confirmed this week— both from Pakistan and only 1 positive environmental sample!

Wild Poliovirus Cases reported this year: Sixty-four (64)—23 in Afghanistan and 41 in Pakistan. The goal is that there be ZERO cases of paralytic polio Type 1 by the end of 2025. (See chart below)
