Earl and Sharon on PETS

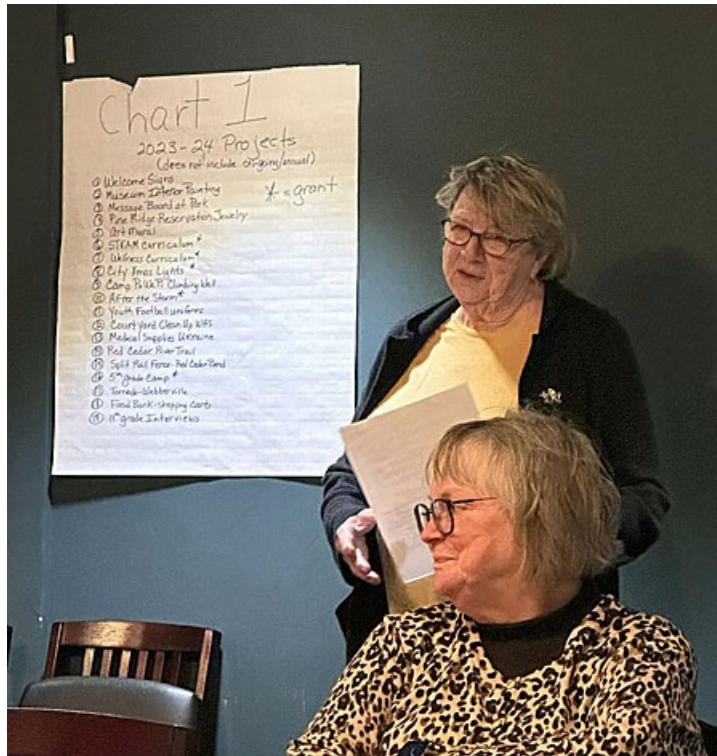
- 2 weeks ago at PETS, 500 President Nominees and President Elects from Michigan, Ontario and Indiana
