
May 25, 2021 Michelle Beloskur Micro Plastics, Anyone?



- There was an early rush lined up to get in at 10:30 am
- After an hour, there was no line to get checked in
  - But a steady flow of people who came to get vaccinated
  - From noon to 2 pm, it was a quick check in, shot, wait 15 minutes and done!
- Raj noted that the CDC will soon announce approval of Pfizer for 11-15 year olds
  - That should increase traffic next week
- Wonder why the pace is dropping off
  - Some people are hesitant to get the vaccine
  - Some who got the first shot, are skipping the second think safe enough
- Jim mentioned a Free Press article Ask another if they had the vaccine
- Kay talked about a Polio Plus Society
  - To be a Charter Member donate \$100 per year to Polio Plus

    - Pledge to do that till polio is eradicated possibly for 4 more years
      Want to join contact Ingrid or Ed Foster (see your District Newsletter)
  - Rotary and partners have caused a 99.99% reduction in polio since 1994
    - Only 2 countries (Afghanistan & Pakistan) have wild polio
    - Hesitancy to get a vaccine they don t understand • Kind of like US in some people
- Asked if there is another plan to help out at Sparrow?

- If demand falls off, Sparrow may be doing local vaccination clinics
- Scheduled to do one in Okemos and Bath now
- If get a group of commitments, could bring to Williamston
- Raj joined us late (as she, Jim & Naomi & Narda switched to the 2-6 shift)
  - She said the flow was steady the rest of the day
    - They had more than they expected show up
  - Future dates:
    - When the age is lowered, will have more come in
    - More opportunities in the future
  - The government is looking for trusted community individuals to get the word out
    - With our Polio experience, that should be us Rotarians
- On Tuesday, May 11<sup>th</sup> in McCormick Park at 11 am the Senior Center will have a Picnic and Annual Meeting
  - Susie Cockerill has invited us to join them
  - They want to thank us for all of our support
- Earl talked about the Sign Committee progress
  - They plan a large ♦ Williamston Welcomes You♦ sign
    - At 3 entrances to downtown � N-E-W
    - Estimated cost at about \$500 each
    - Reached out to Kiwanis to help pay for the signs (and get their name on them)
