Drop-off Locations: Coats can be dropped off during our Rotary meetings during the month of October.

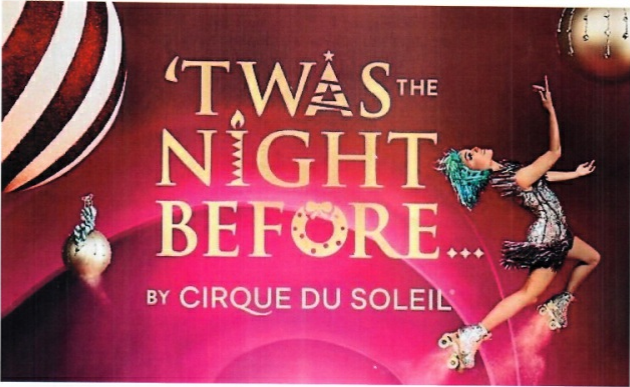
Spread the Word: Share this initiative with friends, family, and colleagues. The more people we reach, the more coats we can collect!
